

2026 AAUSBC CITY CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Eligibility is open to all "adult" members of the Aberdeen Area USBC Association
2. You may only bowl once in the single event. Senior Singles and Senior Doubles will be virtual events.
3. **Doubles and singles can be bowled on the same shift ie: 1:00pm or can be broken up such as, Singles at 1:00pm and doubles a different day and/or shift time.**
4. You can bowl unlimited entries in doubles with a change of partner. You have to bowl both the doubles and singles events to be eligible for the senior virtual event. When bowling the senior double both bowlers must be at least 50 years of age (as of Jan 1, 2025) and must bowl the event together.
5. You can bowl more than once in team event with a change of two (2) partners.
6. The first score bowled in the team, doubles, and singles events will be used for the handicap all events and senior single divisions.
7. You do not have to bowl doubles and singles together, they are separate events. To be eligible for all events and special scratch you have to bowl both.
8. Special scratch is the highest two games in both doubles and singles. Doubles scores will be taken from the first double event bowled.
9. The payout of the prize fund will be 1 in every 5 entries. All prize money will be distributed 100% in the event that it was collected.
10. Entry fees for the team, doubles and singles events will be per person, per event, divided as follows:

Bowling Fees	\$11.25
Tournament Exp	\$3.00
Prize Fund	<u>\$15.75</u>
Total Owed	\$30.00

The entry fee for the optional events will be \$5.00 per event
9. Handicap will be 90% of the difference between your average and 220.
10. Averages: All entrants shall use your average as of last year. If you do not have a previous average, average will be calculated on 21 games this season. If you have less than 21 games, you will bowl scratch.
11. Entry fees must be paid in full at the time the entry form is turned in. (NO EXCEPTIONS)
12. You will bowl your first choice of time and date unless the tournament manager has contacted the team captain.
13. Fresh oil will be applied after every 2 shifts.
14. Senior singles & doubles are virtual events. Your first recorded scores will be used for the optional events.
